'Plein air' workshops in the Walpole Wilderness area

The French term *plein air* means out of doors and refers to the practice of painting entire finished pictures outdoors.

Take a 'plein air' outdoor workshop with local artist/palaeoecologist Elizabeth Edmonds from Petrichor Gallery and be inspired by the Wilderness. You'll learn some of the natural history of the area, nature journaling, principles of landscape watercolour painting and tools of the trade to paint in the field.
